Visits and Tours Information 2016

This leaflet outlines the Peace Museum's visitor and tour programme for adults and adult groups for 2016.

Who we are

The Peace Museum occupies three small, unique galleries in Bradford City Centre and is the only museum of its kind in the UK. The Museum does not just provide a detailed history of peace and peace movements through a 7000 item collection, but also asks people questions that relate to the past and the present and reflect upon how these may inform and transform attitudes and actions today.



Current permanent exhibitions include 'Responses to Conflict', an exhibition exploring how peace groups responded to major conflicts of the 20th century and early 21st century; 'Common Ground, Uncommon Women' tells the story of the women of Greenham Common; and the Bradford Room uncovers Bradford's hidden peace history. The collection covers a wide range of topics from pacifism and resistance, campaigning, anti-nuclear protests, encompassing the histories of various movements, religious groups and individuals who have campaigned tirelessly for peace.

What we offer

Visits and Tours:

General Museum Visit and Guided Tours

The Peace Museum is open to the public every Thursday 10am till 4pm and individuals and groups are welcome to 'walk in' on this day. If groups are visiting on a Thursday it is helpful if prior notice is given so that staff can be on hand to provide an introduction and guidance through the exhibitions if requested.

Group visits can also be arranged on other days by prior arrangement. These visits can involve a general tour of the galleries and objects of interest, or can be more specific relating to a pre-determined theme of topic. This can also include a general introduction to the Peace Museum, our history and our work.

Bradford Routes to Peace Heritage Trail

The Routes to Peace Heritage Trail visits places of interest within Bradford city centre and the surrounding area. The trail is approximately 2.5 miles long, which takes around 90 minutes to complete. It is accompanied by a printed guide which is available at the Peace Museum free of charge, and the Routes to Peace Aurasma App for smartphones. The trail not only takes you to places of interest but tells the story of Bradford's history and its longstanding affinity with peace, including sites such as the J.B Priestley statue and Bradford Pals Battalion memorial. The Peace Museum can be used as a base, either to store bags and lunches and/or can be used as a space for lunch. The trail may be of interest to walking groups or local history groups. A downloadable copy of the trail guidebook is available on our website.



Study Days

The Peace Museum can function as a venue for a group study day. Groups are welcome to use the exhibitions and objects on display as a point of study and staff can tailor this to a specific topic by prior arrangement, or provide support for the group's study leader.

Other bespoke sessions can also be arranged. Contact staff to discuss your ideas on how the Peace Museum space could be used.

Pricing

The Peace Museum is a charity. We have modest charges for sessions which are designed to cover costs. The group size for each session is maximum 30 adults for general visits and tours. If chairs and tables are required for group work the maximum is 15 adults.

General Visits: Free

Guided Tours/Talks: Free, however donations are welcome to cover staff time.

Heritage Trail Visit: Free, however donations are welcome if using the Peace Museum facilities.

Study Days: A charge will apply depending on requirements. This will be discussed upon booking.
